



Announcement of the Faculty of International Studies

Subject: Teaching and learning management for students who do not wish to take a summer semester abroad for students in the Bachelor of Arts: International Business (China) (International Program) Revised Curriculum 2020 and International Studies (International Program) Revised Curriculum 2020, Chinese Studies Major

To complete the Bachelor of Arts in International Business: China, Revised Curriculum 2020, and the Bachelor of Arts in International Studies (Chinese Studies Major), Revised Curriculum 2020, students are required to study during the summer semester in the first, second, and third years for not less than eight weeks or as determined by the curriculum management committee regarding a foreign university as specified in the study plan.

Currently, students in the aforementioned programs have been experiencing many problematic issues, including financial problems or a lack of economic liquidity in their families, health problems, personal problems, and feelings of insecurity about current world situations. These problems make it difficult for them to travel to study during the summer semester at a foreign university, as specified in the study plan and by the university.

The faculty therefore specifies the conditions and guidelines for teaching and learning management for students who do not wish to study during the summer semester at a foreign university, following the designation in the study plan and of the university as shown in the following details:

Students must comply with the following conditions:

1. Students must express their wish not to study during the summer semester at a foreign university within the 10th week of the first semester.
2. Parents must give written consent for the student not to study during the summer semester at a foreign university.
3. Students who express a desire not to study at a foreign university during the summer semester are unable to change their minds.
4. Students must pay the full summer semester tuition fee according to the period specified by the faculty.
5. Students must study at a foreign university at least once.

Other guidelines or conditions for arranging teaching and learning depend on the faculty curriculum management committee.

Practice guidelines:

1. Thai students and non-Thai students (whose native language is not Chinese) must submit their HSK examination results to confirm their level of Chinese proficiency as a substitute for the lack of direct experience and the development of communication skills in Chinese abroad. The HSK score level requirements are as follows:

Year	HSK score level
Year 1	Level 4 (≥ 210 points)
Year 2	Level 4 (≥ 240 points)
Year 3	Level 5 (≥ 210 points)
