




**AGREEMENT OF IMPLEMENTATION
ON THE STUDY ABROAD PROGRAMME
BETWEEN
YEUNGNAM UNIVERSITY (YU)
AND
FACULTY OF INTERNATIONAL STUDIES (FIS)
PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, PHUKET CAMPUS (PSU)**

Through a friendly discussion, the representatives of YEUNGNAM University, Republic of Korea (YU) and Faculty of International Studies (FIS), Prince of Songkla University (PSU), Phuket Campus have reached the following agreement.

1. For the study program at YU, YU will accept PSU students of the International Studies Program to study two courses at YU, totaling (6) credits as detailed below:
 - 1.1 Korean for Presentation and Conversation 3 credits (60 hours)
 - 1.2 Business Korean 3 credits (60 hours)
2. The duration of the study program will be a minimum of (60) days from May to July 2024.
3. YU will accept the minimum number of (6) students at a cost of approximately 2,074.22 US Dollars per person, which is equal to 2,700,000 Korean Won based on the currency exchange rate of November 15, 2023. FIS will be required to make payments in Korean Won. The aforementioned cost per person includes tuition fees, class-related materials, on-campus accommodation, and round-trip transportation from Gimhae International Airport to the accommodation.
4. As PSU students possess accidental insurance valid in all countries, they are not obligated to purchase one from a Korean company during their stay in the Republic of Korea.
5. Any issues not explicitly mentioned herein or forthcoming matters shall be resolved through friendly discussions between YU and FIS, PSU.

6. This agreement shall become effective upon being signed by both parties and will remain in effect for 1 year. Mutual consent regarding future work or subsequent phases must be reached through further discussions in due course.
