hereinafter referred to as Parties

Preamble

Bearing in mind a mutual interest in cooperation, the Faculty of International Studies (FIS), Prince of Songkla University, Phuket, Thailand (hereinafter referred to as Party A) and Sichuan Yiman Vision Technology Co., Ltd., The People's Republic of China (hereinafter referred to as Party B) are signing this Agreement of Cooperation, with the aim of promoting the FIS and enabling the candidates from the partner to enroll in International Programs at FIS.

§1. The Area for Cooperation

Party B is willing to recruit students for undergraduate programs offered by Party A.
Party B is willing to recruit students for post-graduate programs offered by Party A.

§2. The Rights and Obligations of Party B

1. Party B shall present the information regarding programs offered by Party A and the relevant application conditions on its website.
2. Party B shall consult and honestly inform potential candidates of study programs, recruitment processes, and terms and conditions of studying at Party A. Party B shall collect student applications for the study programs offered by Party A applying through Party A's or PSU registration system.
3. Party B will be a representative of Party A in Sichuan Province and Chongqing, The People's Republic of China.
4. To facilitate the completion of a BA or BBA program application, Party B will provide a verification letter in English for high school, vocational school, or higher vocational qualifications. The corresponding certificate must be notarized by the Notary Public Office of China.
5. To facilitate the completion of an MA program application, Party B will provide an undergraduate verification letter in English for each candidate. The certificate must be notarized by the Notary Public Office of China.
6. Party B will conduct a pre-departure orientation program on basic life skills and introduction to Thai culture to students.
7. Party B will accompany the students to PSU Phuket in time for the orientation program.
8. Party B will assist the students in obtaining a student visa and other travel documents, and ensuring that the students have sufficient health insurance.

9. Party B will send successful BA or BBA applicants to PSU Phuket before the semester 1 (August) starts. If Part B will send the successful applicants to PSU Phuket in the second semester (January), there must be the minimum number of 15. If there are fewer than 15 successful applicants, the starting dates of the program will be discussed.

§3. The Rights and Obligations of the Party A

1. Party A will provide Party B with general information about the international programs, as well as other necessary details, such as recruitment rules, application procedures and deadlines.
2. Party A shall inform Party B of any changes to the programs at least three (3) months before the recruitment of each batch.
3. Party A will charge a management fee of 50,000 THB form each high school or vocational school candidate and 40,000 THB form a higher vocational school candidate to complete the BA or BBA program.
4. Party A will charge a management fee of 30,000 THB from each candidate to complete the MA program.
5. Party B shall receive the commission for each accepted student from Party A as follows:

Bachelor's Degree

1 to 20 students = 15,000 THB each

21 to 50 students = 20,000 THB each

51 students and above = 25,000 THB each

Master's Degree

1 to 20 students = 15,000 THB each

21 to 50 students = 20,000 THB each

51 students and above = 25,000 THB each

6. Party A will accept high school or vocational school students into the BA or BBA programs, requiring a minimum of 3.5 years or 10 terms to complete the degree.
7. Party A will accept higher vocational students into the BA or BBA programs, requiring a minimum of 2 years or 6 terms, along with one business trip, to complete the degree. A maximum of 70% of the credits from previously completed courses may be transferred.
8. Party A will accept students into the MA program, requiring a minimum of 1.5 years or 4 terms to complete the degree.

9. Party A will issue appropriate documents for student visa application purposes, although it is the responsibility of the individual student to obtain the visa.
10. Party A will conduct an orientation program at PSU Phuket for new students from Party B.
11. Party A will arrange on-campus accommodation if required and subject to availability.
12. Party A will provide Party B with all the necessary information to promote Party A's programs and to communicate with prospective students and parents.
13. Party A will award Party B's students who have completed their undergraduate study with a bachelor's degree certificate in the same manner as any other PSU Phuket regular students.

§4. Third Parties

Neither Party shall transfer its rights and obligations resulting from this agreement of cooperation onto any third parties without the written agreement of either Party.

§5. Confidentiality

1. This Agreement of Cooperation between the two Parties is confidential.
2. The Parties oblige themselves not to share with any third parties any information included in this agreement, which is an agreement in writing between the Parties.

§6. Terms and Termination

1. This Agreement of Cooperation shall enter into force from the signature date by both Parties and will remain in effect for three (3) years, and it will be evaluated annually to assess the number of accepted students.
2. The Agreement of Cooperation may be due for revision or termination at any time under the mutual consensus of both Parties. If Parties do not propose to revise or terminate the Agreement, it will stay in force for the agreed period of time specified at clause 6.1.
3. This Agreement of Cooperation can be terminated by either Party under one (1) year' prior written notice. In such a case, all the obligations of the Parties resulting from this document and any due responsibilities until this date remain valid.
4. Party A may terminate this Agreement if Party B does not comply with any of the relevant rules and regulations described in this document.

§7. Changes and modifications

Any modifications or supplements to this Agreement of Cooperation shall be binding only in writing under penalty of nullity.

Bachelor's Degree programs:

(International Business: IB)
2. Bachelor of Arts
(Languages and Cultures: LC)
 - Korean Language and Culture: KLC
 - Chinese Language and Culture: CLC (not recommended)
 - European Language and Culture: ELC
 - Thai Language and Culture: TLC

High school or vocational students

Required Documents for Admission (IN ENGLISH)

1. High school or vocational school certificate in English with a notarial certificate by the government.
2. High school or vocational verification letter by school in English.
3. A copy of a valid passport
4. A copy of one of the following English Proficiency Test scores taken within two years before the application date:
 - a. TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication) score of 450 or higher, or
 - b. IELTS (International English Language Testing System) score of 4.5 or higher, or
 - c. TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score: Paper-Based 455, Computer-Based 107, Internet-Based 67 or higher, or
 - d. Duolingo English Test score of 60 or higher, or
 - e. English score of National College Entrance Examination (NCEE) or Gaokao of 90/150 or 70/120 (Jiangsu) or higher.

For those who cannot provide for the application a certificate as specified in TOEIC, IELTS, or TOEFL, Duolingo, or NCEE, FIS will arrange a TOEIC mock exam (online) with a 1,000 THB exam fee/person and a study plan based on the student's language proficiency as follows:

Tuition Fees

Successful recruited students shall pay the following tuition fees:

1. Admission fee of 20,000 baht
2. Management fee of 50,000 baht
3. Tuition fee of 41,000 baht per semester (10 semesters altogether)
4. Dormitory fee of 19,600 baht per student per semester for a double room, plus 6,000 baht for deposit.

Higher vocational school students

1. Higher vocational school certificate in English with a notarial certificate by the government.
2. Higher vocational school's verification letter by student's schools in English.
3. A copy of valid passport
4. Pass PSU Phuket English test administered by PSU Phuket or have a copy of one of the following English Proficiency Test scores taken within two years before the application date:
 - a. TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication) score of 450 or higher, or
 - b. IELTS (International English Language Testing System) score of 4.5 or higher, or
 - c. TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score: Paper-Based 477, Computer-Based 153, Internet-Based 53 or higher, or
 - d. Duolingo English Test score of 65 or higher, or
 - e. English score of National College Entrance Examination (NCEE) or Gaokao of 100/150 or 80/120 (Jiangsu) or higher.

For those who cannot provide for the application a certificate as specified in TOEIC, IELTS, TOEFL, Duolingo, or NCEE, FIS will arrange a TOEIC mock exam (online) with a 1,000 THB exam fee/person and a study plan based on the student's language proficiency as follows:

Tuition Fees

Successful recruited students shall pay the following tuition fees:

1. Admission fee of 20,000 baht
2. Management fee of 40,000 baht
3. Tuition fee of 41,000 baht per semester (6 semesters altogether)
4. Dormitory fee of 19,600 baht per student per semester for a double room, plus 6,000 baht for deposit.

Tentative Recruitment and Application Period

1. The official recruitment and application period will be announced on a year-by-year basis.
2. Applicants should submit documents to Party A by May to enroll in the first semester (August) of each academic year, or by September to enroll in the second semester (January) of the academic year.
3. The admission fee and management fee are to be paid only once.
4. If an undergraduate student takes more than 10 semesters (from high school) to complete a degree program, the tuition fee from the 11th semester onward will be 20,500 baht.
5. If an undergraduate student takes more than 6 semesters (from a higher vocational school) to complete a degree program, the tuition fee from the 7th semester onward will be 20,500 baht.

BA students

Required Documents for Admission (IN ENGLISH)

1. BA certificate in English with a notarial certificate by the government.
2. BA verification letter by university in English.
3. A copy of a valid passport.
4. A copy of the English Proficiency Test scores taken within two years before the application date (optional).

Tuition Fees

Successful recruited students shall pay the following tuition fees:

High school or vocational students

1. Admission fee of 20,000 baht
2. Management fee of 50,000 baht
3. Tuition fee of 41,000 baht per semester (10 semesters altogether)
4. Dormitory fee of 19,600 baht per student per semester for a double room, plus 6,000 baht for deposit.

Higher vocational school students

1. Admission fee of 20,000 baht
2. Management fee of 40,000 baht
3. Tuition fee of 41,000 baht per semester (6 semesters altogether)
4. Dormitory fee of 19,600 baht per student per semester for a double room, plus 6,000 baht for deposit.

Master's Degree

Master's Degree Required Documents for Admission (In English)

1. Bachelor degree in Chinese Studies, Chinese Language, or in a related field.
2. Undergraduate's diploma with a notarial certificate by the government.
3. Undergraduate transcript with a notarial certificate by the government.
4. A copy of the English Proficiency Test scores taken within two years before the application date (optional).
5. Undergraduate's verification letter by student's university.
6. A copy of valid passport.

Remark: Those who are eligible to enroll in the program must pass the English admission interview.

Master's Degree Tuition Fees

Successful recruited candidates shall pay the following tuition fees:

1. Management fee of 30,000 THB. The management fee includes co-curricular activities, workplace visits and special lectures.
2. Tuition fee of 45,000 THB per semester for a total 180,000 THB (4 semesters).
3. An on-campus dormitory charge of 19,600 THB per student per semester for a double room, with a deposit of 6,000 baht. (optional)
4. For those who cannot provide an English proficiency test certificate as referred below, they must enroll in the English for Graduate Studies with a tuition fee of 20,000 THB per course (maximum 2 courses).

Degree Completion

1. Graduate students must conduct a minor thesis in English with a minimum of 7,000 words.
2. Graduate students must pass the English proficiency test for graduation requirements as the minimum score of each test determined by the Graduate School.

Application Period

1. The official recruitment and application period will be announced on a year-by-year basis.
2. Applicants should submit documents to Party A from March 1st – June 1st to enroll in the first semester (August) of each academic year, or from August 1st – November 1st to enroll in the second semester (January) of each academic year.
